

Information pursuant to Art. 13, 14 and Art. 21 of the General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR)

Ladies & Gentlemen,

If you enter into business relationships with us as a customer or supplier, personal data will be processed by our company. We inform below, in accordance with Art. 13ff. GDPR, on the processing of your data and, in accordance with Art. 21 GDPR, on your rights under data protection law.

What type of data does Eberhard process?

When you contact us as a customer or supplier, we process the following data categories:

- Base data e.g. Name, Address, contact person
- Communication data e.g. phone number, email address
- Contract data e.e. begin and termination of contracts.
- Billing and payment data e.g. advance payment claims, payment information, bank details, open claims.

What do we process the data for and on what legal basis?

The data processing takes place for the purpose of the conclusion of the contract and the execution of the contract. The processing of your data is necessary according to Art. 6 Para. 1 b) GDPR for the conclusion and fulfillment of the contract with you. In addition, data processing is required in accordance with Art. 6 Para. 1 f) GDPR to safeguard our legitimate interests. Our legitimate interests exist in connection with the fulfillment of mutual obligations from the contract between us and you and the maintenance of the business relationship. If you have given your consent, the data will also be processed for the purposes of establishing contact with you for advertising purposes. You can object to the use for these purposes at any time.

Who do we transfer your data to?

Within our company, only those departments have access to personal data that need it to fulfill the above-mentioned purposes. As far as necessary for the execution of the contract and the resulting obligations, we will, if necessary, transfer your data to credit reporting agencies, residents' registration offices, law firms, courts, debt collection agencies or bailiffs.

Will data be transferred to a third country or to an international organization?

A transfer of your data to a country outside the EU does not usually take place.

How long do we keep your data?

The data will be stored for at least as long as is necessary to carry out the business relationship.

In addition, we store your personal data as long as there are corresponding legal retention requirements (e.g. from commercial or tax law). Here the deletion only takes place after these deadlines have expired.

Is there an obligation to provide data?

The processing of the collected data is necessary for the conclusion and implementation of the business relationship between us and you. If we do not process the data, we will not be able to fulfill our contractual obligations towards you. This does not apply if you only object to processing for advertising purposes.

What data protection rights do you have?

Art. 12-23 GDPR regulate the rights of the data subject, i.e., your rights with regard to the handling of your personal data. These are the essential ones:

- Right to information at the latest at the time of collection in accordance with Art. 13 GDPR, which we comply with this information letter.
- Right to information according to Art. 15 GDPR
- Right to correction according to Art. 16 GDPR
- Right to deletion according to Art. 17 GDPR
- Right to restriction of processing according to Art. 18 GDPR

- As far as applicable: right to data portability according to Art. 20 GDPR
- Right to object to processing according to Art. 21 GDPR
- Right to lodge a complaint: You have the right to lodge a complaint with a data protection supervisory authority at any time.

Information about your right of objection according to Art. 21 GDPR:

You have the right, for reasons that arise from your particular situation to object at any time to the processing of personal data relating to you, which is based on Art. 6 (1) f) GDPR (data processing based on the weighing of interests). If you object, we will no longer process your personal data unless we can prove compelling legitimate reasons for the processing that outweigh your interests, or the processing serves to assert legal claims or to defend against them.

You have the right to object to the processing of personal data for advertising purposes at any time. If you object to processing for advertising purposes, we will no longer process your personal data for these purposes.
